The International Conference on Educational Technologies 2020 (ICEduTech 2020) received 71 submissions from more than 17 countries. Each submission was reviewed in a double-blind review process by an average of four independent reviewers to ensure quality and maintain high standards. Out of the papers submitted, 15 got blind referee ratings that published them as full and short papers, which meant that the acceptance rate was 21%. Some other submissions were published as reflection papers.
